OFFICERS MEETING

11:30 am at the Claim Jumper Restaurant

Items Discussed:

1. Report from the Treasurer. The current bank account balance is \$856.37. Sherri Fair requested to be reimbursed for postage (overnight USPS delivery of CFHC flyers to Sharon Pizzuto for distribution at the Horse Expo, \$17.50, and 42 cents for a classified ad invoice) The officers approved the reimbursement.
2. IBOP test provisions. Norma reported that she had emailed Marc Dileo to inquire about some information stated on the IBOP requirements form. The form states that "The FPS will assign the arena or the grounds where the tests will take place, and is responsible for the availability of the necessary requisites". Norma asked Marc for a definitive explanation of this statement. Marc answered, basically, that it is the KFPS responsibility to provide the necessary requisites, and the method they use to accomplish this is to provide North America with a KFPS Affiliate, namely FHANA, who will then designate Keuring sites that will make the IBOP test available. Then it is the Keuring Site Host's responsibility to fund and provide the actual necessary requisites, and the Site Host may divide and distribute these funding costs between Keuring and IBOP horse entry owners as deemed appropriate.
3. Discussion about the Keuring. Cheryl Jones has been designated as Site Host, so we will have to wait and see what, or if, Cheryl will ask the CFHC to assist with the Keuring, and then we will discuss our options. We came up with a few possible ideas. Norma suggested catering a lunch, but there were concerns that if the Keuring were to be hosted at the DCF, it lacked an appropriate space for a catered lunch. There was also concern that the number of anticipated horses to be inspected and tested would make it impossible to organize a lunch away from the Keuring Site, due to lack of time. Sherri suggested arranging for a photographer and videographer. The objective would be to make these services as affordable as possible for all of the Friesian owners who would want to have photo or video done for their horse while it is being presented in class, but that there would be a discounted rate for CFHC members. We also discussed a possible raffle, where each horse entered by a CFHC member would automatically receive a raffle

ticket, and all non members would have the option to purchase a raffle ticket. We would need to obtain donated raffle items. The raffle could be drawn, either during lunch time, or at the end of the Keuring.

4. Possible Clinics, such as Bruce Griffin for Keuring prep and presentation, a “spook” clinic at 8th Heaven Farms, a riding IBOP clinic by Gigi Brittain, and a driving clinic, clinician to be determined, were a few suggestions.
5. CFHC Logo. Norma mentioned that she has a friend who may want to create a CFHC logo at no cost, as a donation to the CFHC. She will let us know if this idea comes to fruition.
6. Planned our first membership meeting. The date is May 3, 2009. We discussed possible meeting topics, the meal and entertainment.
